

Waterfront Director – Mt. Desert Island (near Bar Harbor), Maine

The Waterfront Director will be part of the senior camp management team in managing the overall direction of the various camp programs at the waterfront including recreational and instruction swim, boating (kayaking, canoeing, and sailing), fishing, and raft-building. The Waterfront Director will work alongside the Camp Director to enhance the quality of programs based at the waterfront, ensure the programs are well organized, camper-centered, safe, and related to the mission and core values of the camp.

All staff must also adhere to all of the health and safety laws set forth by the State of Maine Dept of Human Services Youth Camps Division, and standards for accreditation with the American Camping Association.

Requirements – At least 21 years old and experience (or at the very least training) in supervision of camp waterfront activities. Must enjoy working with children of all backgrounds, and passionate about working outdoors and engaging campers ages 7 – 13. Must have the ability to supervise staff and assist program staff with planning programs.

Preferred Qualifications – Bachelor's degree and at least two years of related work at a camp with supervisory responsibilities. If no degree, equivalent work experience required. Current WSI and / or Lifeguard Certification.
