



Program Instructor – Boating (Sailing, Canoeing, Kayaking)

Minimum qualifications: At least 18 years of age, and one year’s experience instructing boating activities with youth including: Canoeing, Stand up paddleboarding, & Kayaking. Must enjoy working with children of all backgrounds, and be passionate about working outdoors and engaging campers ages 5 – 15.

- Weekly Salary Range: \$585 - \$625 (DOE and Certifications)
- Possible Housing
- Commitment: Mid-June through end of August
- All staff must be CPR/First Aid certified

Preferred qualifications: Bachelor’s Degree in process and at least two years of direct experience instructing boating.

- Hold a valid Lifeguarding certification, or be willing to obtain one (we will train)
- Boating Safety Course certification

Camp Beech Cliff welcomes qualified applicants for the Boating Program Instructor position. This instructor plans instructional and experiential activities to help every camper learn and enjoy boating in all its forms. The ideal Program Instructor will teach some one-time introductory lessons for campers ages 7 – 11 years; and assist in teaching weekly multi-day boating programs to a dedicated group of campers ages 9 – 15 years. All staff must adhere to the health and safety laws set forth by the State of Maine Dept. of Human Services Youth Camps Division, and standards for accreditation with the American Camping Association.

Considerations: Applicants should realize that camp jobs are challenging, demanding, and require a great deal of patience and understanding. Personal lifestyle sacrifices may have to be made including disconnecting from daily use of digital technology during the camp day. At CBC, sensitive and dynamic leadership is necessary to provide youngsters the opportunity to grow, learn to positively relate to others, establish life-long values, and increase their appreciation of the natural world.
