Traditional Camps

Our four grade-based traditional camps—Starburst, Thunder, Lightning, and Quasar—are designed to match the social, emotional, and physical development of campers. For instance, Starbursts have two dedicated counselors per camper group, and more transition and "down" time. Thunder campers are introduced to most camp activities throughout the week, travelling with a close-knit camper group and dedicated group counselor. In addition to scheduled waterfront activities, Lightning and Quasar campers will choose two program 'skill classes' to explore during the week to allow for more in-depth projects and skill building. Most of the day, each camper is part of a small group to ensure familiarity and relationship building. At the same time, everyone has the opportunity to participate in periodic all-camp events and Camper Choice when campers choose the activity with which to end their day.

The typical camp day consists of three blocks: Waterfront, Topside activities and Camper Choice. Along with Morning Circle, Lunch and Closing Circle, campers have a very full and active day!

Waterfront

Each traditional camper will spend one block at our Echo Lake waterfront either swimming or boating. The boating program includes, kayaks, canoes, Corcls, Stand-up paddleboarding and sailboats. While at the waterfront, all campers are supervised by our certified lifeguards, program heads and counselors. PFDs are provided and required for all campers that need more swim experience* and for all boating activiites. Boating over to the bluffs and jumping from rocks into the lake is a popular activity.

Topside Activities / Skill Classes

Most camp program areas are located "topside" in the cabin, the playing fields and surrounding woods. Thunder campers will rotate through all the program areas through the course of the week, getting a sense of all that camp has to offer. Each week, Lighting Campers and Quasar Campers will each pick one to two programs in which to concentrate and develop advanced skills.

Camper Choice

All campers gather on the field for the last block of the day: Camper Choice! Each program area announces their activity for the afternoon and every camper gets to choose how they wish to close out their day... basketball or swimming, or something more chill and creative in arts & crafts or pottery.

* Each Camper takes a swim assessment on their first day of camp. Swim lessons will be offered for campers each afternoon during the camper choice block.
